READ and ASK: 2 Corinthians 9:6-15; Mark 12:42-44; Matthew 23:23, Matthew 6:24, 16:24-26; Acts 20:35

- What do these passages teach us about giving generously?
- What are spiritual valuables found in "giving generously"?
 - o Why is "giving generously" essential for the journey we travel (being and making better followers of Jesus)?
- What are the physical valuables found in "giving generously"?
- Which passages stand out or challenge you most? Why?
- How can our material possessions be a threat to our faith?

APPLY:

- Is there anything that keeps you from giving generously?
- How has giving generously been a benefit to your spiritual growth?
- Next step: How do you need to begin giving generously or give more generously?
