READ and ASK: John 13:1-17; 1 Corinthians 12:12-31: Romans 12:3-8

- What it the purpose of God giving people spiritual gifts?
 - Why is it important to understand the difference between serving the church and volunteering in the community?
 - o How do they have different purposes?
- Why is serving the church an essential step in the journey we travel (to be and make better followers of Jesus)?
- Which passage stands out or challenges you most? Why?
- How is serving the church both a posture (John 13) and a practice (Rom 12, 1 Cor 12)?
 - o How is serving the church both "corporate" and daily?
 - o How do you think serving the church gets minimized in the western church?

APPLY:

- How can this group help you to serve the church better?
 - o How can you serve the church **in** and **through** this group?
- Next step: What do you need to commit to in order to serve the church as God intends?

For just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, so in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others. - Romans 12:4-5
