

UNSTOPPABLE TEAM: A team of generosity

November 2, 2025 Discussion Guide

Scripture reading: Colossians 3:23-24; 2 Corinthians 8:1-2, 9:6-7; Matthew 6:19-21

CHECK UP:

*Memory Work: And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching. – Hebrews 10:24-25

*How did you experience or share true biblical encouragement this past week?

OPEN:

- What was a highlight in your week this past week? What was a particular challenge you had?
- How have you intentionally engaged with the church family this week?

READ and DISCUSS, what does each passage teach us about giving and being a team of generosity? Psalm 24:1; Luke 16:13; Luke 21:1-4; Matthew 6:19-21; Matthew 23:23; 2 Corinthians 8:1-5; 2 Corinthians 9:6-8; Acts 20:35; 1 Timothy 6:17-18

- Which passage stands out to you most? Why?
- What has your attitude been towards generous giving?
- Why is regular, sacrificial, giving with no strings attached an important discipline for a follower of Jesus?
- It has been said that being a Christian “costs us nothing” but is also “costs us everything.” How is that true?
- In what way are Christians stewards?

APPLY:

- How does the knowledge that all you have belongs to God impact your life?
- How does the topic of generosity challenge you most?
- NEXT STEPS: What is one step you can take to further practice regular, sacrificial, disciplined generosity?

Memory Work:

Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. – 2 Corinthians 9:6-7
