CHECK UP:

OPEN:

- Who did you B.L.E.S.S. this past week? What action steps did you take?

READ and ASK: 1 Peter 5:1-14

- What stood out to you in this text?
 - What did you read that was new or fresh to you?

- What does this text teach us about God?
- What does this text teach us about ourselves?

APPLY:

- What has this text taught you about how a disciple of Jesus should live?
 - How are you falling short of this (these) truths?
 - How can this group help?
- What truth from this passage can you share with someone else?
- Next step(s): What is one practical step you can live out this week?
