Scripture reading: 2 Timothy 2:1-2; Romans 16:13; 2 Timothy 1:5; Deuteronomy 6:4-9;
Psalm 100:5

CHECK UP:

*Memory Work: For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline. – 2 Timothy 1:7

*What steps did you make to walk in the Spirit this past week?

OPEN:

- What was a highlight in your week this past week? What was a particular challenge you had?
- How have you intentionally engaged with the church family this week?

READ and DISCUSS: Judges 2:8-13; 2 Timothy 2:1-2; Romans 16:13; 2 Timothy 1:5; Deuteronomy 6:4-9; Psalm 100:5

- What most stood out to you from the message/testimonies this past weekend?
- Which passage stands out most to you and why?
- Passing down the faith from generation to generation is instructed and “assumed” in much of scripture. Why do you think the people of God have always needed such reminders?
 - o What do you think keeps the people of God from passing on the faith to the next generation?
- Passing on the faith to the next generation can take place in many different relationships. What different relationships come to your mind?

APPLY:

- How were you spiritually invested in by a previous generation?
- What opportunities do you have to pass your faith on to the next generation?
- NEXT STEPS: What is one intentional step you can take this week to spiritually invest in the next generation?
