- What does 2 Corinthians 6 add to our understanding of the boundaries of Christian friendship?
- What do you think would count as "friendship with the world" today?
 - o What does James's claim that some forms of friendship make one make on an enemy of God add t our understanding of God? Of friendship?
- Why does the subject of "a team of friendship" matter?

APPLY:

- How has your faith impacted your understanding of real friendship?
- How do we reach the world without become friends with the world?
- What impact would it have on the church and on the world if we practiced biblical friendship?
